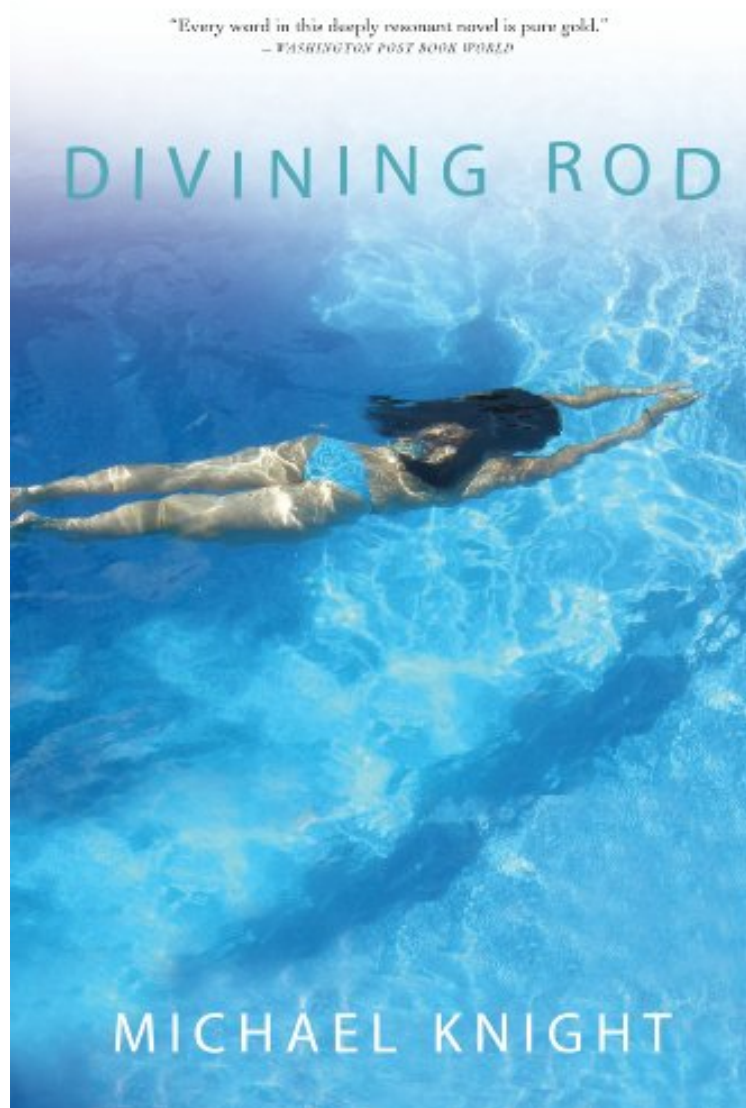

Ultimately, *Divining Rod* is trivial. Not merely is the subject matter common, but it is not elevated by language in any sense, nor does the author explore meaning, seek to examine the human heart in conflict with itself. Rather, Knight's novel can be seen as a "Torn Between Two Lovers" pop song that ends in death. Compared to *Cold Mountain*, this novel reads like an MFA project promoted due to connections. It isn't terrible; it simply isn't good.
