Despite Lysette's beauty Simon finds he doesn't connect with her and in fact he wonders if she's slightly mad. However, just a few days later he sees Lysette at a masked ball and finds himself fascinated by her allure. It's not long before he realises that they are twins and that Lynette, the sweet and soft twin, believes her sister Lysette died two years before. Thus begins the hunt for the mysterious man, L'Esprit, who has been blackmailing Lysette's keeper Desjardins and who also caused much anguish to Lysette's mother twenty years before. With a subplot of an attempt by Lysette to learn secrets from Edward James, secretary to Benjamin Franklin, there are plenty of plot threads to keep the story going. This book was fairly well written with the characters delineated effectively although this reader found the similarities between the names Lysette and Lynette added rather a lot of confusion whilst reading the book. The story began twenty years before with information about the twins' mother and I found that part of the book rather unnecessary. The interactions between Simon and Lynette seemed rather far-fetched in that historical era and I didn't find myself caring particularly for any of the characters.
