In a nutshell; it's awesome. Much better than the first one. In more detail and without spoiler: I think part of why I didn't warm up to the first book was because of the present tense narrative and the unusual pacing. It all felt smoother and easier to read this time around. Or maybe that was just me taking some time to get used to it. For whatever reason, that doesn't change the fact that I was completely engrossed in the story. I could easily connect to Justine (almost too much at times. I don't want to imagine people chewing on my poor tummy) and I pretty much read the whole book in one go. The last quarter of the book sitting on the edge of my seat. Captivating, indeed. The world-building is another thing I simply adore in this series. Nowadays reading Urban Fantasy you bump into vampires left, right, back and forth. And if not, there are weres, angels or fairies to take their place. Carolyn Cranes novels are refreshingly unique in this regard. Also I have to point out Justine and Packard's fascinating relationship. Intense and light, happy and painful and just so very real. Love it. Finally, the ending.
