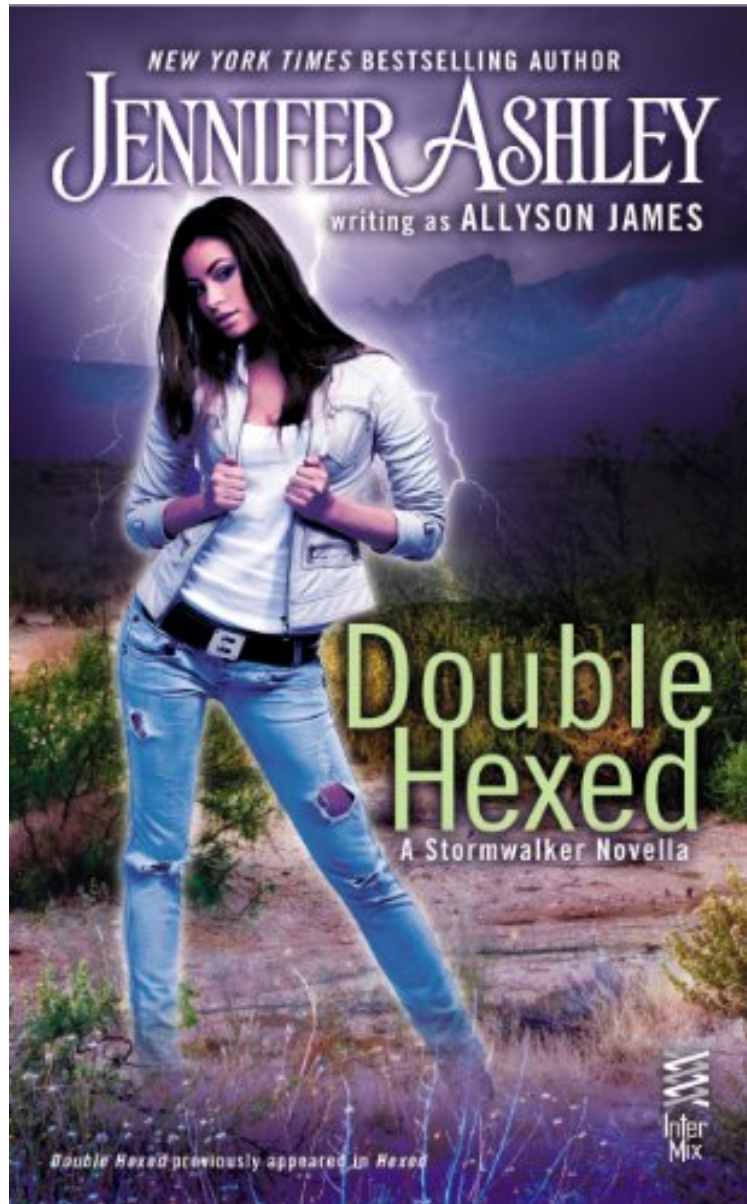

Neither characters, nor the story's frame of reference will make any sense, if one doesn't know the original series. If you're new to Stormwalker, I recommend to start with book one. Review This is one of the very few novellas in a series that manages to be as gripping and well rounded, as the main books are. It starts with a very usual day in the life of hotel-owner and magic-wielder Janet Begay: Fremont comes over to do some repairs, rooms are cleaned and one by one most of the various characters of the series appear. And when they discover that they are hexed and can't get out of the hotel and others cannot get in, they all stay cool. For a while. Up until the s**** starts to hit the fan: the hex brings out everyone's greatest fear and weakness and is far more encompassing than firstly thought to be. And a good while Janet tries to stay the team-leader doing the prep talk and keep people working on a solution. But with each thing they try, things get worse until Janet is haunted by scary visions of the future and a disturbing sacrifice has to be made. OK, this is as much as I can tell about the plot without spoiling it. As I wrote above, most novellas for me are not as good and serious as the main books in a series, but this is one that shook me as much as the books do, maybe even more, because the escalating danger with things getting more desperate by the minute just got to me. And the author managed to introduce some hints of impending doom in the future, so the novella really attributes to the series as a whole as well. And character-wise Double Hexed presented the different every person in more detail, because you never learn more about a person but when they are desperate and under extreme pressure. They showed a great lot of their true colors. If you like the Stormwalker series, I totally recommend the novella to you. You'll surely like it.
