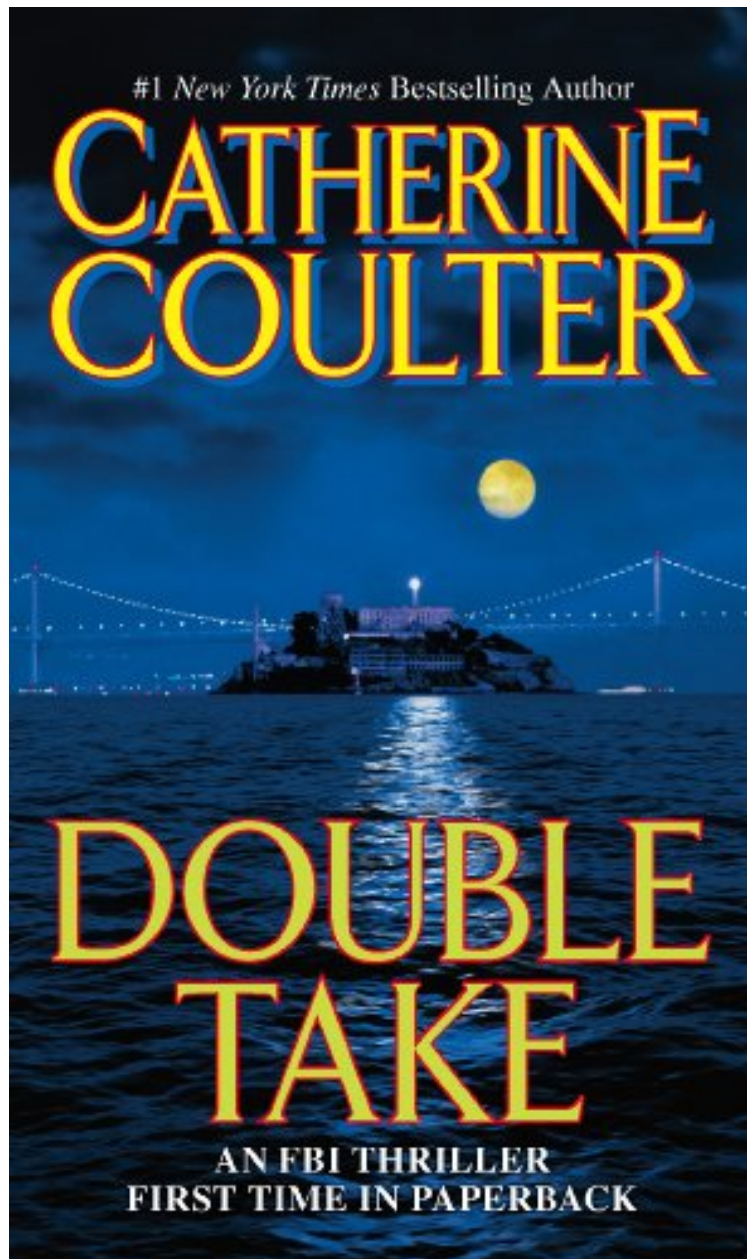

It turns out the young, beautiful Julia is a widow; her much older celebrity-psychic husband, August, was recently savagely murdered.
