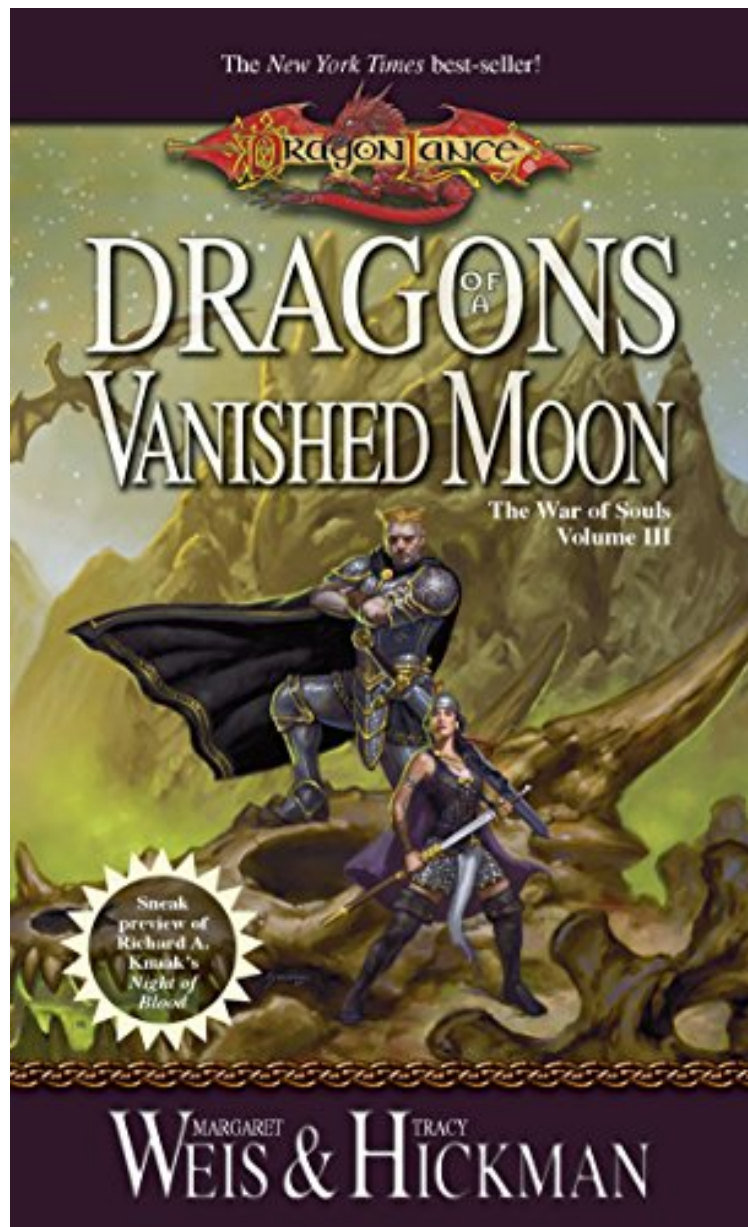

Am Ende des zweiten Teiles vom 'War of the Souls' sind die Mächte des Guten gerade mit aller Macht dabei den Krieg gegen die Bösen zu verlieren. Zu allem Schlechten gesellt sich noch, das nach und nach immer mehr, die man eigentlich zu den Guten gezählt hat, auf die Seite des einen Gottes zu wechseln, von dem man mittlerweile weiß, dass es Takhisis ist. Die Spannung, die in den ersten beiden Teilen der Trilogie aufgebaut wurde, arbeitet sich langsam zu einem Höhepunkt, da die Probleme der wenigen Guten, die noch im Kampf übrig geblieben sind, immer mehr werden. Go and get this book now. This is without a doubt the best DL novel yet (Opinion). So here is my review as spoiler free as I can make it. (If you have not read the first 2 books in the series do not continue, it will spoiler them for you.)
