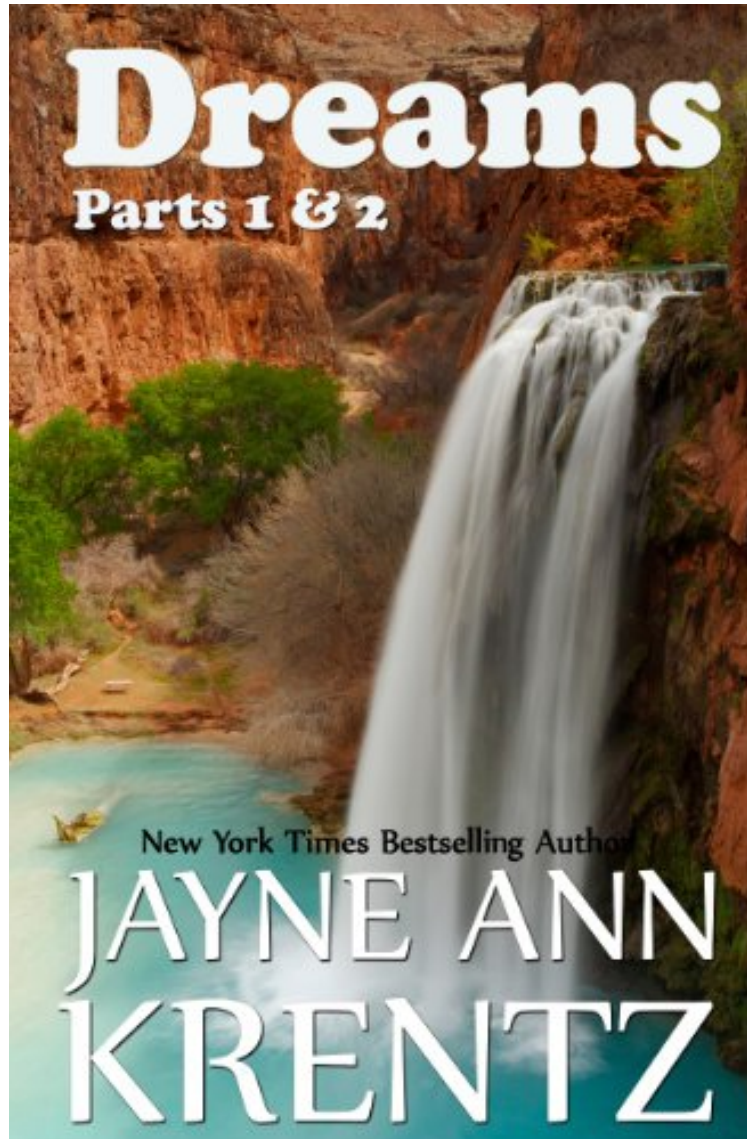

I don't know if JAK self-published it in Ebook format, or if someone holding the license did so, but there are a few errors, such as missing punctuation marks, which a comptent proofreader should have dealt with.However, the main

problem is with the story and the characters, which demonstrate just how quickly society and mores have changed from the time this story was written. JAK, bless her, included what must have seemed a feminist theme at the time, yet her hero's caveman tendencies, if tempered by some better qualities, and the attitudes and remarks of several supporting characters, seem dated and almost quaint these days. ("Why haven't you ever married?" - the female lead is constantly put in the defensive on this subject, and her own mother blesses the hero for finally getting her away from her career focus.) She includes a paranormal element, as in many of her later works, but I'm not sure that it really adds much to the plot, and it underlines how old-fashioned some of the values espoused by the male protagonist are. As a longtime fan of JAK, I bought this book (hitherto unknown to me) mostly for curiosity, but it definitely is not on a par with her best work.
