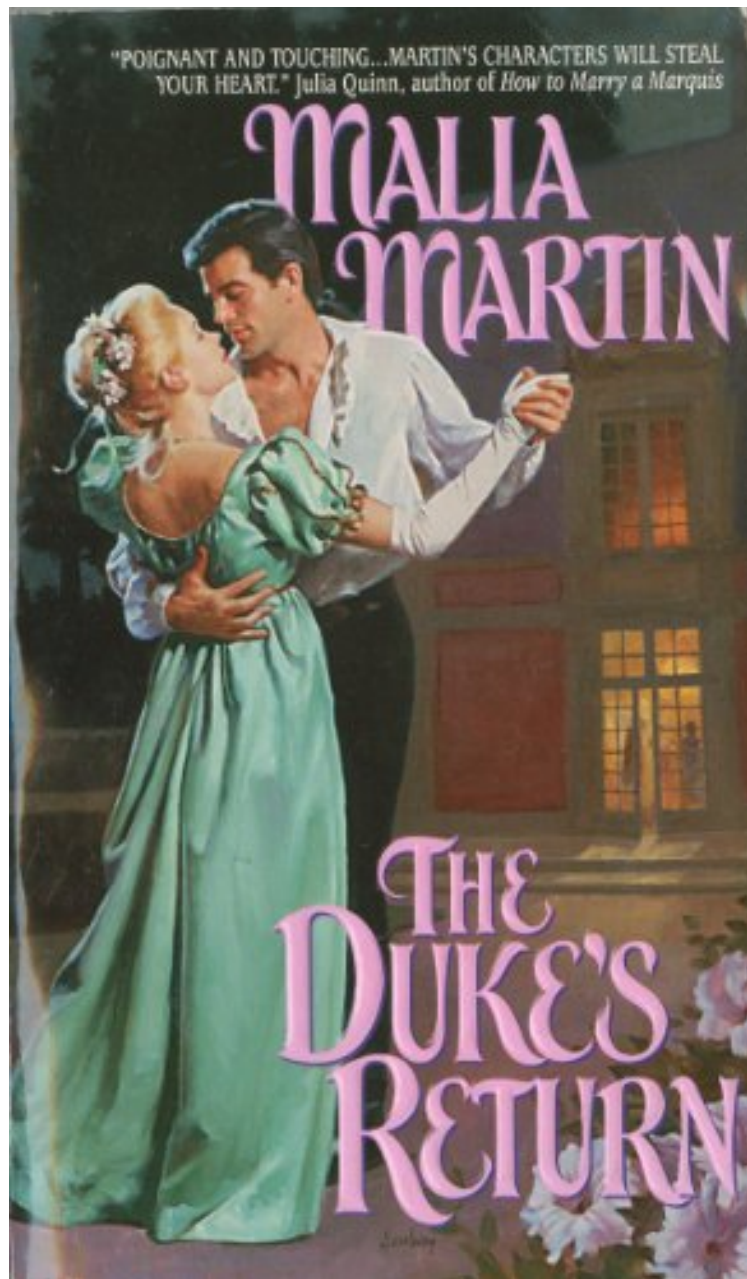

What first attracted me to 'The Duke's Return' was the glowing reviews given by others, but sad to say, the book didn't live up to expectations. I found the characters mismatched and irritating. Trevor (a.k.a. the duke) came across as an insecure and weak person.
