I got that there was some conspiracy going on, but it felt that too much time was spend on whatever lead up to that, and subplots that didn't add all that much to the overall progress. Felt a bit like a very long prologue, perhaps - I mean, I could see some other author basically starting this exact same series at the very end of this book.The other thing that left me

rather confused was the romance. Apparently, the protagonist has a "setup" where she's in love(?) with a (girl)friend, but also has a male sex friend. Who wants more; an actual relationship, and he tells her so. Now, previously adamant "I don't want him as more than a friend with benefits" protagonist, basically being emotionally blackmailed, agrees ... and that's it, kinda. It feels a bit too much like "it's modern urban fantasy, so of course we need to be hip and make her a bi character, even if it doesn't help anything". Kind of a shame, since I really liked the idea of those "zombies", and the protagonist seemed to otherwise be fun enough. But I feel this is all too typical, in the long-run. On the one hand, we have a very interesting and different plot: certain people cannot die, but will come back from having been killed etc, and so work for an organisation as stand-ins for other peoples' deaths, i.e. they die and the other person continues living. Jesse is one of those special people, but when one of her customers nearly kills her for good, she realises she cannot trust anyone, and that someone out there is trying to kill all those special people. As I said, interesting plot, a handful of very quirky characters with a burdensome past, a good narration style and plot developments - and still, I just could not get into the story. It did not draw me in like I thought it would; no obvious reason for that, nothing I can put my finger on and say: this is what I did or did not like. On the whole, I found it a tiny bit boring: seemingly uninteresting bits were discussed too long for me as the reader, and the introductory part seemed too long for my taste. Like everything, this is a very personal review, based on my own reading tastes, so my not really praising this story does not mean it is not a good one.
