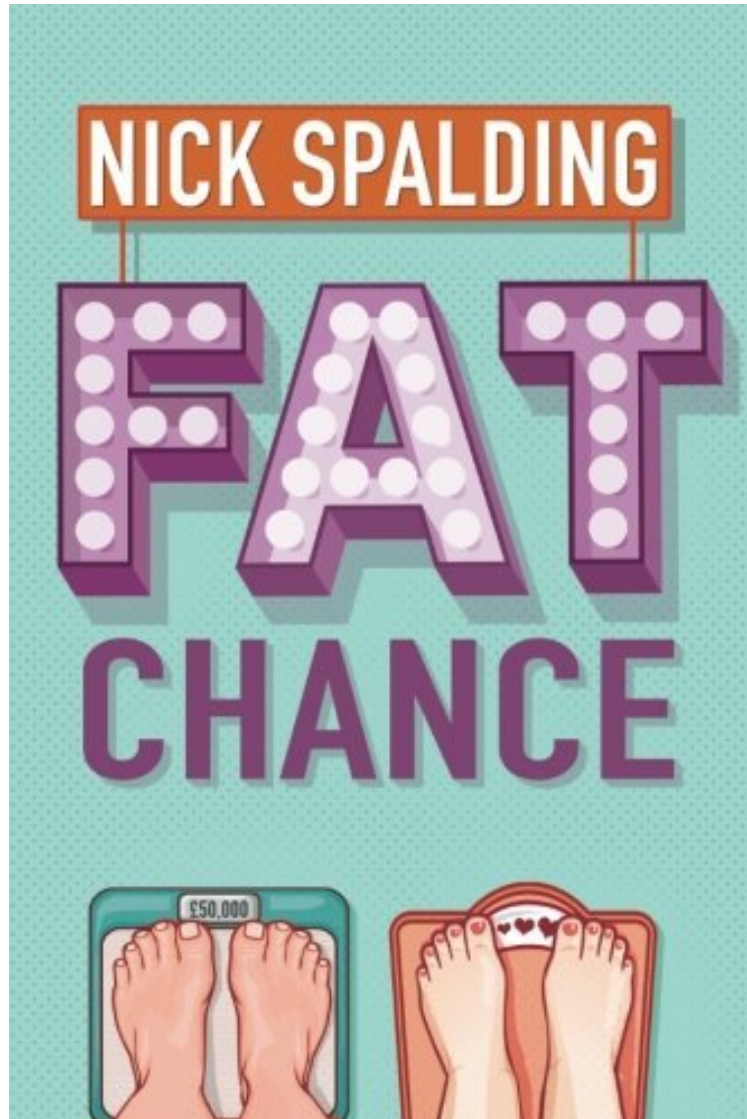

Zwar gut zum "Zwischendrinlesen", und es gibt paar Szenen zum Schmunzeln und Fremdschmen, aber im Groen und Ganzen zu unlustig fr ein "humoristisches" Werk und zu oberflchlich fr einen etwas tiefergrndigeren Roman. Fr den Urlaub vielleicht ganz nett, oder fr die Zugfahrt - einfach zuklappen und vergessen und nach drei, vier Tagen weiterlesen. Noch dazu gibt es etliche Verweise auf Fernsehsendungen und Celebrities, die man nur im Knigreich kennt und mit denen man nichts anfangen kann. Die beiden Hauptdarsteller sind weder gut beschrieben und realittsnah, noch besonders sympatisch. Und das Ende ist sowas von kitschig und rosarot, dass man das Buch nur noch entnervt zuklappt - Groschenroman lt gren! Fazit: Bedingt empfehlenswert; es gibt weit besseres, wenn Humor gefragt ist, z.B. "Email an alle" (englisch "@") von Matt Beaumont oder "The Humans" von Matt Haig.
