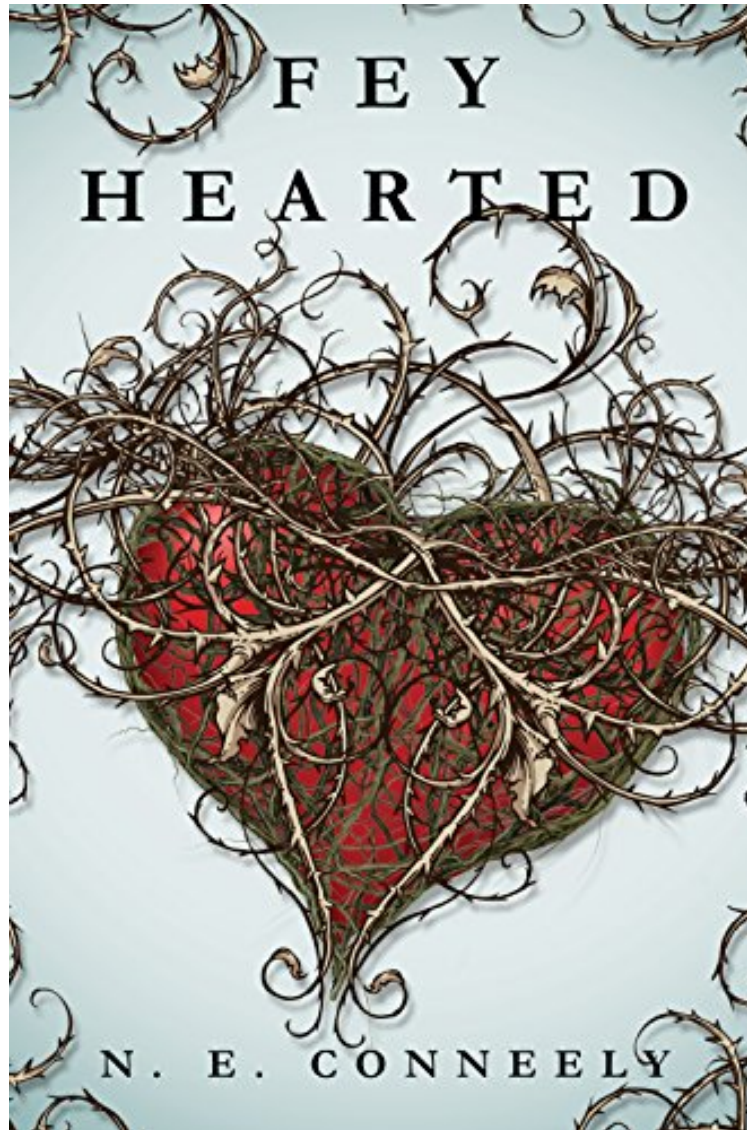

Conneely several times and when she announced that Fey Hearted was published, but totally different from the Witch series, I hoped to love it nevertheless. Conneely offers the prologue and first three chapters on her website to find out if this is a book for you. Right after the first chapter, I bought the book, because I was already invested in the story.Rose is told fantastic

stories by her grandma about the magical world. Stories about dragons and fey and Rose loves them. There is nothing she wants more than to live such a magical life, unfortunately her mother is a deeply practical woman and tries to mold her daughter into a replica of herself with the only goal being to earn enough money for a house and retirement. Rose yearns for the magical, for something extraordinary, though, and no one besides her grandma understands this. As it turns out, magic is real and Rose gets the chance to discover the magical world when she is seventeen years old. Silverlight, a fey transitioning from adolescence to adulthood is eighteen and finds her through her desire for magic inviting her to join him in the fey world to which she takes like a fish to water. But the decision she has to make is a tough one, if she wants to live her fantasy, experience magic and magical beings, she has to leave her family and the whole non-magical world for 100 years. Her family will forget about her, so they won't have to suffer, but she will remember. As much as this book is about the fantastic fey world, about many different magical beings, about the magic in and around the fey or fey hearted, as people like Rose are called, as much as this is about the wonder of discovering your fantasies can come true for you, this book is also about consequences. If she decides to go for what she wants, she has to accept the fact that she won't ever see her family again, 100 years is a long time and they will all be dead when she is able to return. Is it selfish to want that better world for you? Is it selfish to leave your family behind even though they won't remember you? On the other hand, if she refuses, she will be returned to her world without any memory of this night. Can she stand to yearn for something more for the rest of her life? Can she go back there and be somewhat happy? She hasn't been content in her life, but the price she has to pay is steep. And this theme is very much present throughout the book. Decisions have consequences and you have to face these whether you like them or not. Personally, I loved this book. Yes, it was very much different from the Witch series, least of all because it is written in the third person pov, but I loved the world N.E. Conneely created and her magic is that she is able to write three-dimensional characters. Even the minor characters seem to leap from the pages and I had no trouble at all visualizing them. If you like a fantasy world and a story about decisions and consequences, as well as friendship, this is the book for you! Last but not least, her strength is also that she is able to create a heroine and a hero that are both worthy of the same attention and sympathy. There is no need for one to upstage the other, they share the page they are written on and even make room for the sidekicks. I can whole-heartedly recommend this to everyone who wants to dip their toes into the fey world and be transported away for a few hours into a whole new world.
