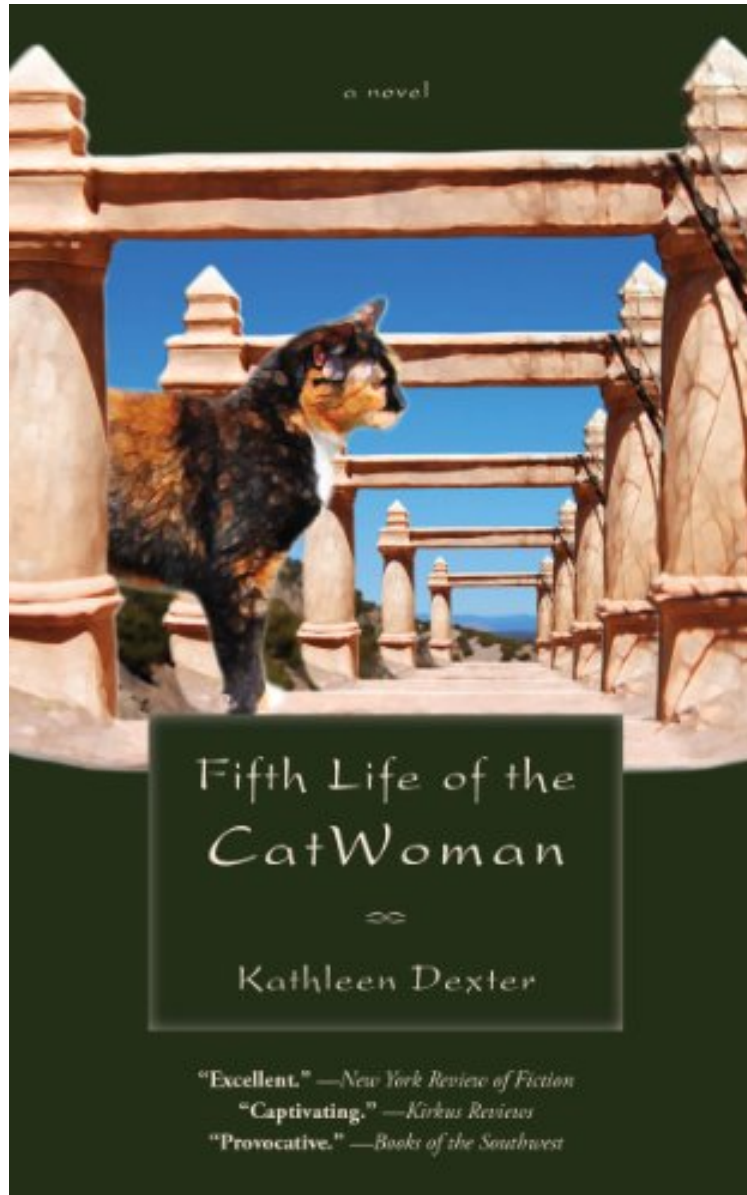

The Catwoman, now in her fifth of nine lives, is hiding out on her mirage with fifty cats, fearful of the outside world because of experiences of intolerance and injustice in her previous four lives. When a mysteriously familiar man arrives on her mirage, she is challenged to do something about making the world a better place so that she will be able to live out her next four lives in peace, as well as making the world a safer place for others. She begins to teach history. But not your average textbook history! Kat teaches -- through stories to her students -- the reality of dire poverty, the absurdity of intolerance toward people who are "different" and the violence of witch hunts, which come in many shapes and forms. Through her teaching, she learns to love and learns that living in fear is a death unto itself. "Fifth Life of the Catwoman" is truly a literary work, full of entrancing descriptions and believable characters (including 50 cats who talk to Kat!).
