Bobbie WAS on the Olympic team. A salary cap is not mentioned in the book. The team is not Philadelphia FIRE, but - for most of the book at

least - THUNDER. Unfortunately, the team is also called LIGHTING (not even Lightning) several times, starting in Chapter one. This may seem nit-picky, but is it so difficult to get a proof-reader proficient in the English language to read a book before it is published?? It detracts greatly from the otherwise entertaining story. I'll overlook and excuse a "between you and I" or "Her and I went shopping.." if it's the character speaking as, unfortunately, many people do make such errors, but they should not be in descriptive text. The errors in editing are two numerous to list all - some are spelling mistakes that no spell-check program can catch: THREW is used several times instead of THROUGH; Connor was "sewing his wild oats" - wonder what color thread he used! There is a QUITE instead of QUIET. There are errors in grammar: "would of done" instead of "would HAVE done" or "would've done". "Make sure the tails (TALES!) weren't too horrible" OK, I will give credit for the correct "too"! Defiantly was used instead of definitely. I stopped writing down the errors - except at 98% where the celebrating characters were doused in Champaign (as in Illinois, I guess that's why auto-correct capitalized it) instead of champagne. Re-edit and re-publish and I'll give the fifth star as I otherwise enjoyed the story-telling.
