2nd book in the Stormwalker UF series and although there are a few reminders of what happened in the prequel, I don't really recommend to start reading here. If you're new to the series, I suggest you start with Stormwalker. Review No rest for Janet the Din Stormwalker and daughter of one evil Beneath goddess: after she barely managed to contain her mother in the Beneath and close the vortex/gate to that place, the stressful events don't cease. The dragons didn't take kindly to the opening of the vortex in the first place and especially Mick not killing his mate Janet for doing it. Mick refused a direct order of the Dragon Council and they took offense. No matter the fact that Janet banned her mother and effectively eliminated the danger the rules have to be followed and besides, now the dragons know that Janet indeed is as powerful as they feared. So it's a given that Mick will be tried by the Council and also that the verdict is already made. True to character, Mick doesn't want Janet involved but Janet and the other dragons have other plans. But the dragon trouble isn't the only problem Janet and friends face. There is the Beneath magic in Janet that surfaces and threatens to overwhelm her time and again. And Native American god Coyote, who reacts to that by threatening to kill Janet if she doesn't stop using it altogether. If it were only that easy for her. She and her friends again and again stumble into danger too great and overwhelming to fight with anything less than the her-powerful Beneath magic [like demon hordes and the like]. Then there are gruesome murders in the town's vicinity that are magical in origin and that Janet has to solve to clear some people's names [including her own]. So like in the first book, there is action galore Janet only rarely gets any reprieves and a lot of times she enters some scene covered in blood and gore. But that makes for a good pacing. Aside the action, this is the book where Janet again has to choose her path and who and what she intends to become. I was impatient at times that Janet took so much s\*\*\*\* from people, saying time and again she is done, but lets people bully her nonetheless. But I have to admit that I loved what I saw when Janet's mind is finally made up about how it's going to be in the future. My other [minor] complaint is Janet's relationship with Mick: I get why he loves her. But try as I might, I don't really know why she'd love him. He is hot, yes, but that would only account for the lust Janet feels, not the deep emotional bond. And especially since the story is told from Janet's 1st person POV, the lust is clearly visible, but the emotion is somewhat lacking. Especially since Janet at times lusts after other guys, too. But I suspend my final verdict on the two of them and read the next installment first. I'm sure the action will continue to be entertaining and awesome and I really like to read about the new and improved Janet besides the hint at the end of Firewalker that there is a really scary new adversary on the horizon for Janet to take on.
