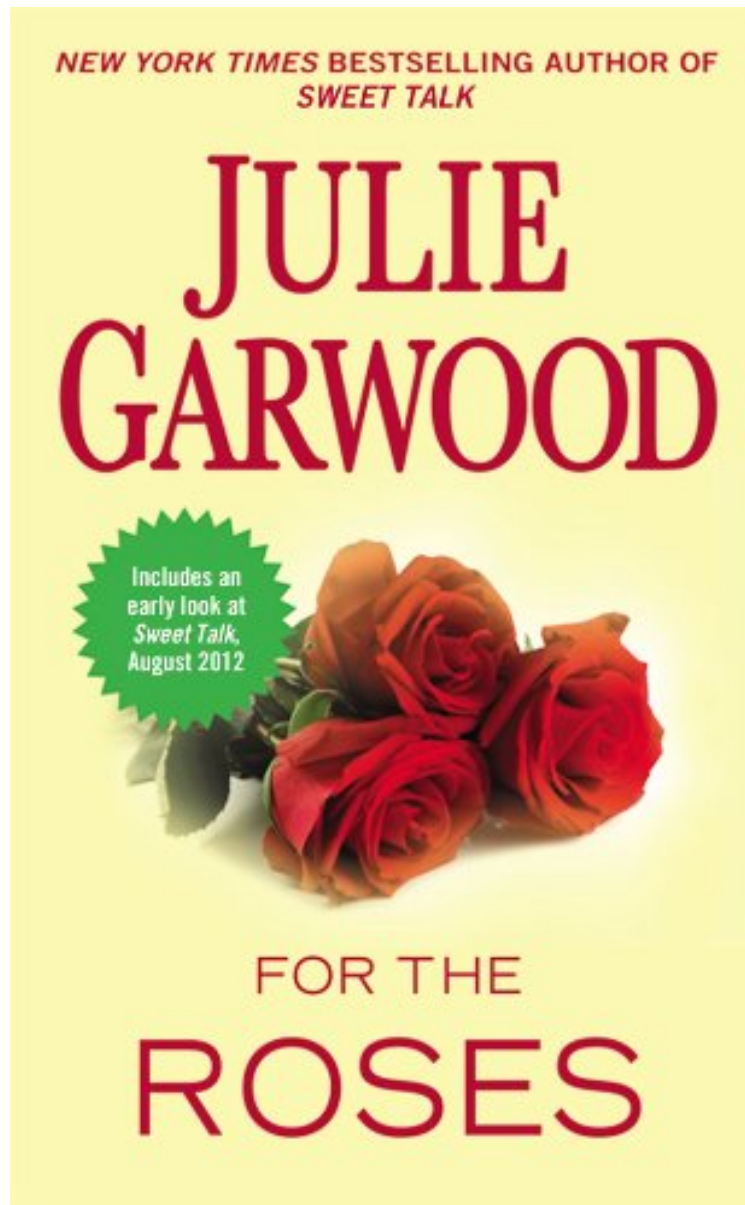

The same goes for Mary Rose who is one of my favorite Garwood-heroines. She is definitely not as silly as some of the others, like Jamie (The Bride, always weeping away) or Sara Winchester (The Gift, who is a complete fool). Her fate, and her complete family's fate really concerned me. I also liked the interspersed letters to Mama Rose which gave me an idea how difficult it was for the boys to raise the baby and also showed how each of them deeply yearned for a mother and readily "adopted" Adam's mother. The book is mainly about family ties and family love and that makes it very touching. It's also very entertaining because of Ms Garwood's gift of storytelling. Her prose is very accomplished and enjoyable and her own special brand of humor is often very funny. I also like the fact that it has less sexual scenes than some of the other books. Once is okay and she has a talent for description, but more of it often interrupts the flow of the story and bothers me. I've taken to overreading those parts lately. Too many novels have trite dialogue or exaggerated sex scenes and Garwood manages to steer clear of both. "For the Roses" entertained me so much that I had to put it down more than once so that I could stop laughing at the antics of the characters. I especially loved her heroine, Mary Rose Clayborne, because the young woman was intelligent, sassy and sweet. She also has a strong streak of common sense not often found in the gloriously beautiful and reckless heroines that populate lesser author's works. Mary Rose is definitely NOT monotonous or vain.
