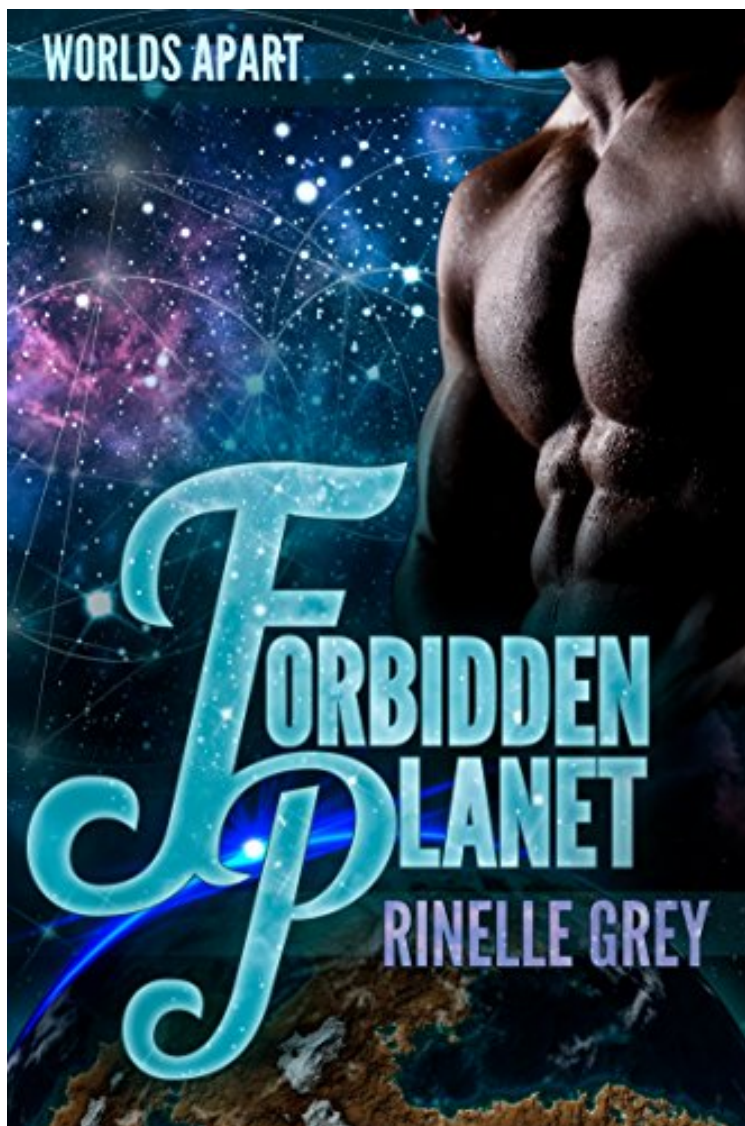

Dumm nur, dass Tyris nun eine Jugendsünde einholt und seine ganze Existenz daran zu zerbrechen droht...Die Romanze hinter dieser Geschichte hat ein SciFi-Setting, das sich auf einige wenige Elemente beschränkt, die nur indirekt für den Plot von Bedeutung sind. Auf der Suche nach einer Lösung für sein Dilemma beschafft sich Tyris ein Raumschiff und macht sich auf die Suche nach einem Vorkommen von Anysogen, dem Stoff, der Raumfahrt ermöglicht und der gleichzeitig auf einem anderen Planeten die Bevölkerung umzubringen droht. Hier leben einige Siedler unter primitivsten Bedingungen, und als Tyris mit seinem Raumschiff abstürzt, strandet er in dieser primitiven Welt. Plötzlich geht es nicht mehr um HiTech-SciFi, sondern um eine archaische Lebensform, die einen an die Amish-Siedlungen in den USA erinnert. Tyris muss sich anpassen, um überleben zu können, und stellt sein eigenes bisheriges Leben in Frage; gleichzeitig nimmt er aus der Distanz des Beobachters die nahezu fanatische Einstellung der Siedler, die alles der Fortpflanzung und damit dem Überleben ihrer Gruppe unterordnen, sehr kritisch wahr, kann aber nicht außen vor bleiben. Mir hat an dieser Story und der zarten Romanze, die sich zwischen Tyris und der Siedlerin Marlee entwickelt, am besten die realistische Schilderung der Lebensbedingungen der Siedler gefallen. Wie schnell Angehörige einer raumfahrenden Zivilisation zurückgeworfen werden können auf ein Leben als Farmer, ist überzeugend in Szene gesetzt und anschaulich erzählt. Mit SF hat dies allerdings wenig zu tun; bis auf einige Zutaten hätte die Geschichte genauso gut auf der Erde spielen können (der Plot hat mich etwas an den Film "Der einzige Zeuge" erinnert). Im ersten Teil der Geschichte wird der Handlungsstrang zunächst aufgelöst, aber es bleiben auch Fragen offen für eine offensichtlich geplante Fortsetzung, in der Tyris vermutlich mit seinem "alten" Leben konfrontiert werden wird. Wer gern futuristische Romanzen liest, kommt hier bestimmt auf seine Kosten; für SF-Fans dürfte die Geschichte weniger attraktiv sein.
