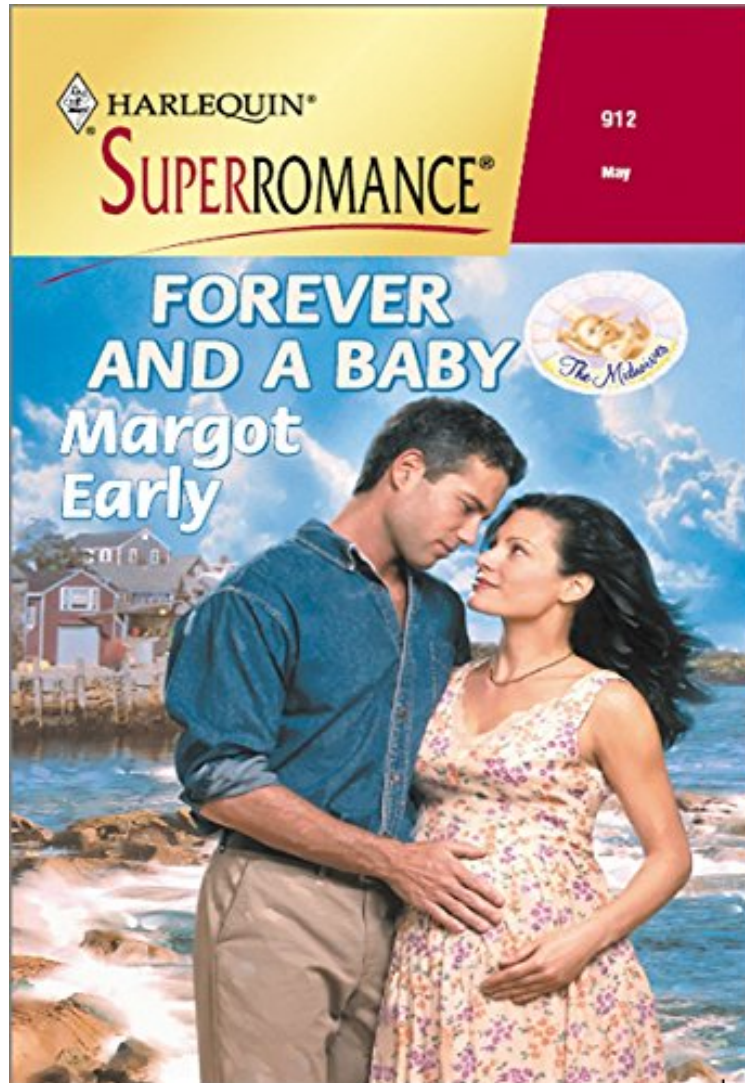

If, on the other hand, you have a working brain (along with the ability to recognize a flashback when you see one - this apparently is rare too) and you want to truly fall in love with the characters and their story then I highly recommend this book.
