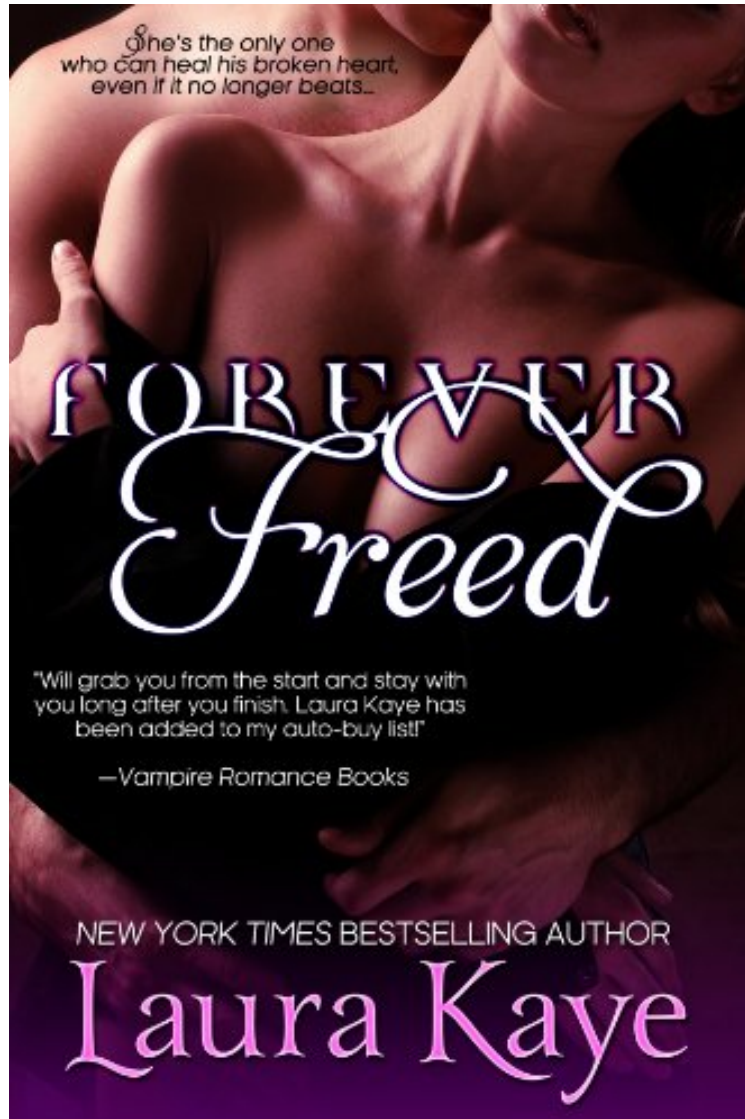

What Lucien doesn't yet know is that fate will take its course and he'll find himself face to face with one of the most powerful emotions of all. Love. The first person narrative was what captured my interest. To see everything happening from the vampire's point of view was exciting and very insightful. I wish there were more books like this. It had me all hot and bothered. At first he literally stalked Samantha's emotions (with the intent to kill her) and I so hoped that his feelings would change. Don't worry, they did. I was able to experience his hunger and sheer animalistic passion for Sam and Ollie develop into protectiveness and love. The sadness he had in him vanished whenever they were near. They made him feel at peace. Obviously this made it impossible, even unimaginable, to drain Sam's blood. A hero who played an instrument 'the violin at that? Could it have gotten any better? I think not. That he was one good looking vilf didn't hurt either. Kaye even made me pine after his fangs. Don't you dare retract them! Fangfuckingtastic. Lucien's age sometimes showed in his way of talking. One could describe him as an old soul with the need for a generous dose of delight. However, there was another side to him. He had welcomed the pain of losing Lena and their daughter Isabetta and didn't care with whom he associated with. For some time he had worked for the oldest vampire of the city. Antoine Laumet ruled the criminal underworld with an iron fist, but he often favored Lucien to his own son. It made Jacques jealous. He resented Lucien for it. The vampire family Lucien grew up with hadn't seen him in a long time. It was heartwarming to witness their reunion. Letting Sam and Ollie in was no doubt the catalyst to seek them out. He needed a push in the right direction I loved every single one of them. Hopefully Kaye will make this book the first of a series. It was great that Olivia played a very important role, and not just as Sam's daughter, but as a sort of saving grace for Lucien. Keeping her company helped him make amends with his past. Ollie's such a sweet and lively girl. You will love her. Ollie and Lucien had a very special bond. It gave the plot an extraordinary touch. More than once I broke into a happy dance because of them.
