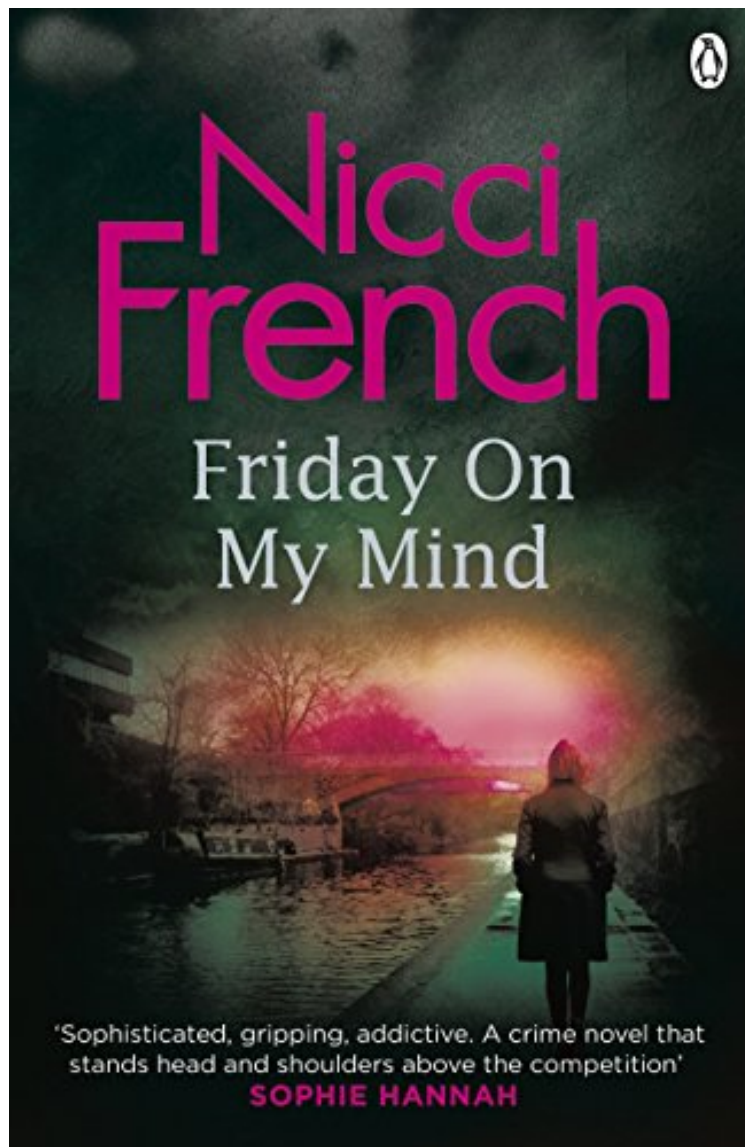

Psychotherapeutin Frieda Klein gerät unter Verdacht, ihren Ex-Freund ermordet zu haben und ist fortan auf der Flucht. Die Handlung ist spannend, wie auch bei den vorherigen Bänden der Serie, das Personal, das einem irgendwie ans Herz gewachsen ist (Josef, Karlsson, Chloe...) ist wieder dabei. Zur Protagonistin Frieda Klein hatte ich bisher ein eher gespaltenes Verhältnis - sie ist nun eben nicht eine, die einem leicht ans Herz wächst, mit ihrer fast schon stoischen Ruhe und ihren eigenwilligen Entscheidungen. Diesmal ist sie regelrecht auf der Flucht, muss immer ihr Quartier wechseln, sich verstecken und das gibt ihr eine Verletzlichkeit, die sie mir in gewisser Weise näher gebracht hat. Neben der spannenden Thriller-Handlung gibt es gelegentlich auch Szenen und Figuren, bei denen ich lachen oder wenigstens schmunzeln musste. Wie Frieda mit Hilfe eines brillenden Kleinkinds und eines Buggys eine Gruppe von Schlägern vertreibt, das hat schon was. Dass Friedas Dauer-Stalker Dean Reeve diesmal eine kleinere Rolle spielt, fand ich ehrlich gesagt sehr angenehm. Diesen Handlungsstrang nehme ich den Autoren einfach nicht recht ab. I found both plot and characters somewhat unbelievable. The in the very last line the authors landed another bombshell on the reader that contradicted everything said before. I guess it should make the reader pick up the next novel which will have something with Saturday in its title. I for one will not. I found Frieda Klein a somewhat annoying and not very clever woman, hard to believe she is a trained psychologist when lacks so much in understanding what makes people behave the way they do. She seems to be unable to give a straight answer, ok maybe because of her profession. Still, it does not make for good reading. The reader is never told why she did not continue the relationship with the man who is found dead in the river Thames. She is surrounded by unbelievably loyal friends, but it does not make any sense why they should be as loyal as they are to this kind of character. Maybe this makes sense when you have read the previous novels but the reader is asked for the suspense of disbelief. Why would anyone in her situation part with half her savings to support a complete stranger, just to find out she is robbed by the same people of the other half. There are many more questions I would like to ask. Somehow both plot and characters did not add up for me to make any sense. I somehow made it through this book and could not believe how the authors ended it supposedly a cliffhanger. To me it didn't make any sense. Maybe I had missed some clues because I did not pay all that much attention because I really didn't like the novel that much? Anyway, I am not curious to find out what happened to Frieda Klein before and definitely not what will happen to her now. I can give this novel only one star and consider it a major disappointment.
