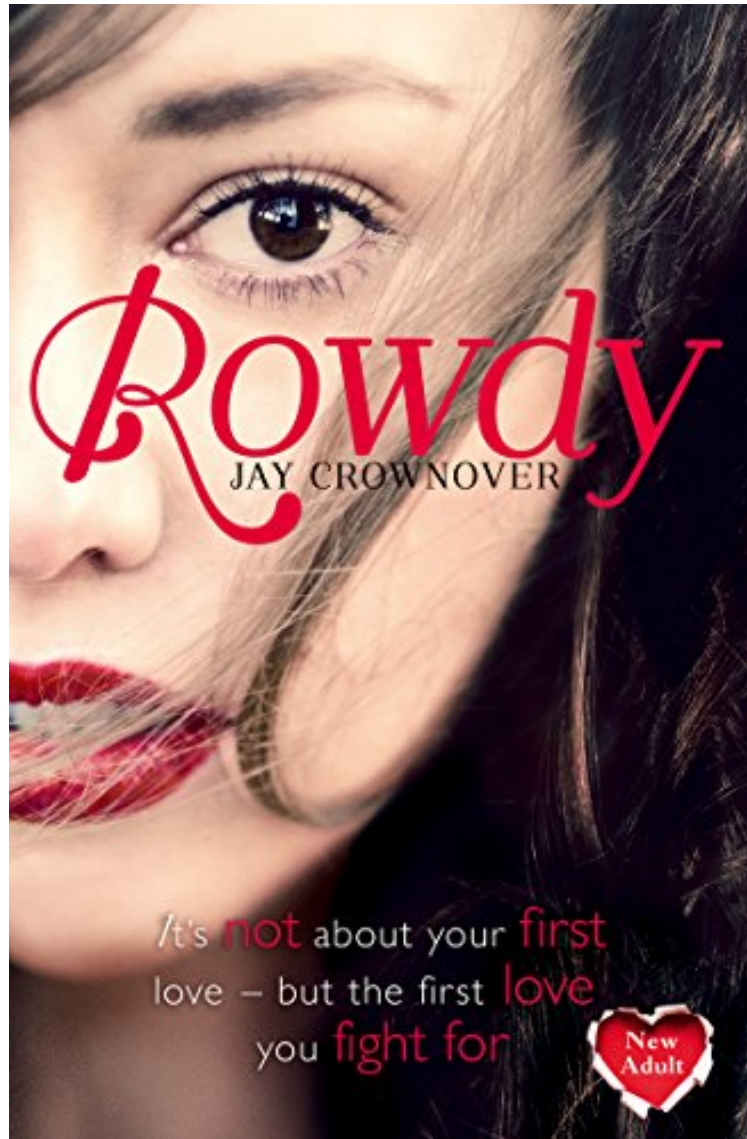

From the start, him and Rule were my favorite, but Rowdys laid-back, contemplative yet sexy and unique character spoke to me. And my first impression was right.Rowdy is an absolutely

swoon-worthy, sweet, emotional, sinfully hot man. A man that after a life full of loss and abandonment has found his true family in the Marked Men crew. He's finally able to be who he truly is and has people that love him that way. He is loyal and protective of the ones he loves, willing to sacrifice everything for their well-being. But when it comes to love and women, he doesn't deal well with emotions and prefers to love 'em and leave 'em, enjoying a good time for a night but not letting anyone into his guarded heart. Guarded, because it has been broken by two women he loved with all his being each in a different way. After the heart-break he is convinced that love isn't in his cards, scared of yet another loss or rejection. But the past has a way to catch up with you, to make you work your issues out no matter if you want it or not. His past comes barreling into his life in the form of Salem, one of the Cruz sisters that broke his young heart. Now he needs to decide if he wants to allow the past to define his future. He needs to figure out if love is worth the risk of a broken heart. And Salem is hell-bent on proving to him, that she's worth it and that she has loved him since they first met as kids. Having been controlled by a strict and conservative father and feeling like a bird in a cage with clipped wings, she's taken the past ten years to define who she is and to find her colorful, larger-than-life personality. Yet no matter what she did or where she has been in the time since she left Rowdy behind, she always knew deep down in her heart that she is missing a part of herself that part being Rowdy. So now all grown-up and free, she is determined to catch him and never let him go again, but with his history with her sister and his distrust that she is here to stay, things are more complicated than she expected.
