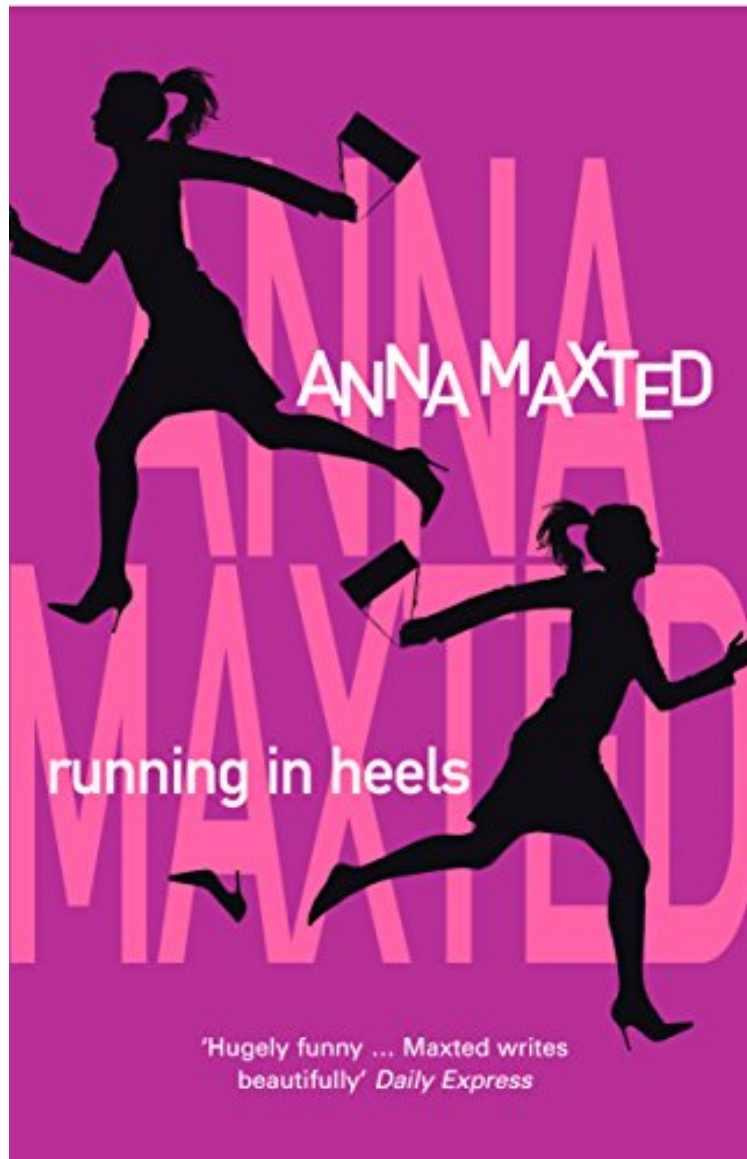

Incredibile - serious issues in a light and funny context Von Ein Kunde After reading the 10.000th article by Anna Maxted in various British magazines I thought I knew everything about her, her life, her husband etc. I wanted to tell her to shut up, keep quiet for a while and write a novel instead as she would suffer from over-exposure if she continued this way. Little did I know that this is what she had already done - and with what result!!! This is an amazing book - it follows the same kind of light-hearted, fast-paced, funny strategy as do most novels in the genre of 'Bridget Jones' but it is far better than the usual 'living in a dump and/or with horror-flatmates/having the job from hell/looking for Mr.Right'-kind of book. The way the story develops follows how Natalie, the main character, realises her own self. So it takes a while until she - as well as the reader - realises that she is on the brink of serious anorexia. Getting her life back on track - the struggles are plenty: redundancy, feelings of abandonment by her best friend, an affair, a 'Mr. Maybe', family troubles with a domineering brother and an over-critical mother and, of course, the 'weight issue' - is a difficult task but definitely much more fascinating than the neurotic cigarette and calorie-counting of a Bridget Jones. Natalie's problems are more serious and seem more real giving this book a lot more depth than other books of the same genre. I just couldn't put this book down and I can't wait for the next book by Anny Maxted. This book is a highly recommended read and really deserves 5 stars!
