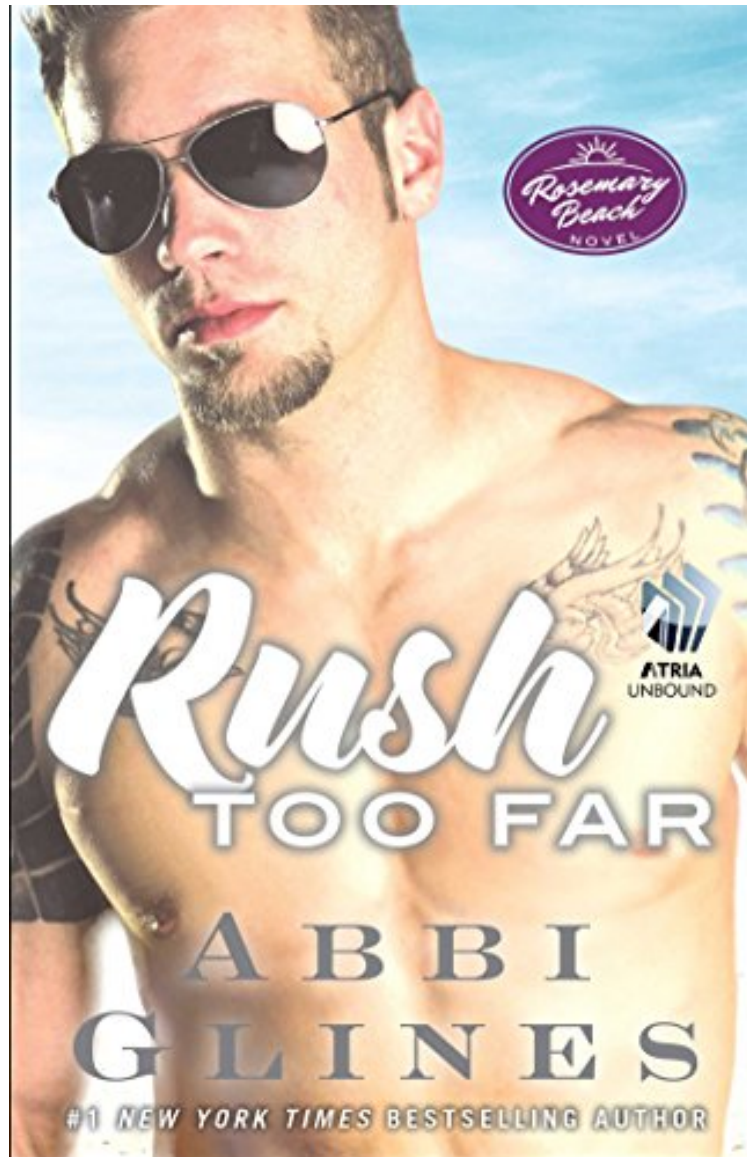

Blaire hingegen ist kein Naivchen und versucht hnderingend ihr Leben ohne Rush in den Griff zu bekommen. Es ist klar wie es weitergeht und doch schmilzt man beim Lesen nur so dahin. Wieder ist es der gefhlvolle und einfhlsame Schreibstil der Autorin, die den Kitsch geschickt verteilt und dabei eine echte Knnerin ist, der diese Geschichte so lesenswert macht. I was looking forward to more drama, more hot love scenes and a great ending. But somehow I couldn't really get into the book. For me there wasn't any real closure in this book. As a reader I need my book characters to get closure to work out their issues so that I have confidence in the "Happy Ever After". I didn't get this in Never too Far. First of all Rush and Blaire. For me they got back together for all the wrong reasons, and in my opinion they started sleeping together again way too early and at a point where I didn't feel the characters were actually ready for this step. I was waiting for these two to really work on their issues but they never really did...especially Rush who is still torn between his love to Blaire and his loyalty to Nan. Because the relationship and history between Blaire and Nan is such a big issue for everyone I was hoping that these two could come to some sort of understanding which in my opinion was a big part of Rush and Blaire getting their HEA, but they never do. I never expected Blaire and Nan to become friends but I was hoping for a little bit more. There is another development in this book that seemed more like a deus-ex-machina-solution so I wasn't really happy about that either.
