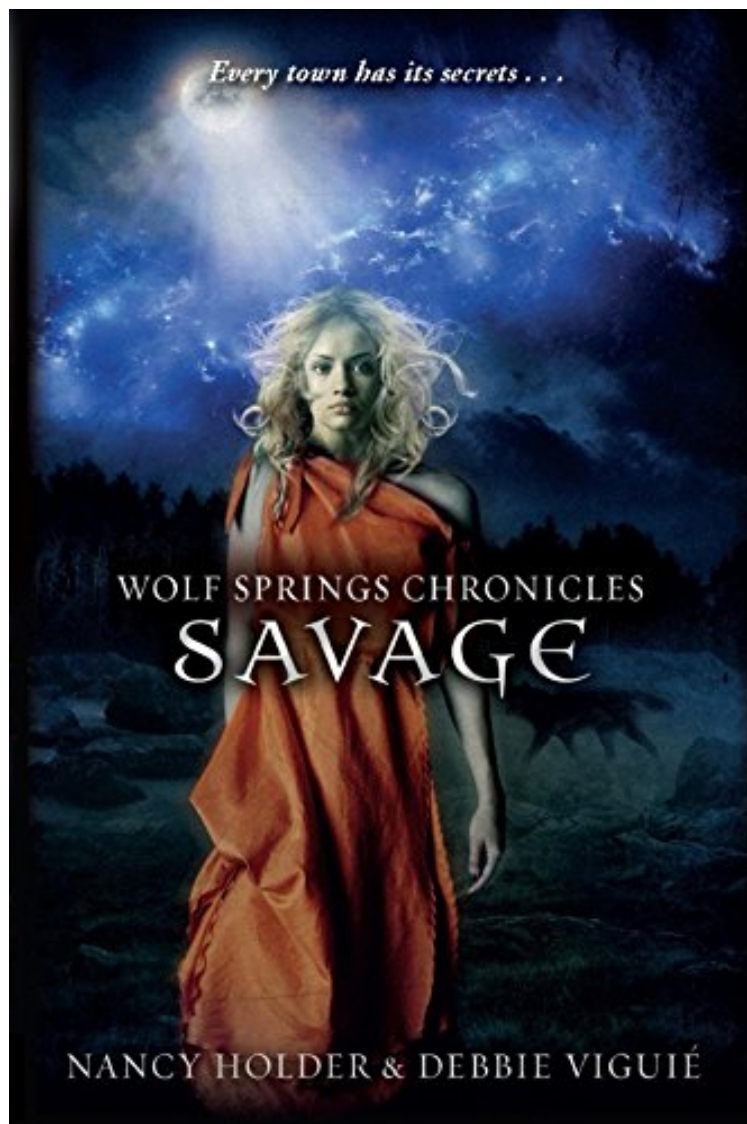

Spoiler Alert: this is the last installment of a trilogy in which all books follow one story arc and accordingly rely heavily on each other. That means the books have to be

At the one hand, I was really interested to get to know how it all ended. Who had bitten the heroine Kat, what would happen with the hellhound, what would happen to her, Trick, Cordelia... and then on the other hand, I had the permanent urge to shake Kat, when I had to read about her stumbling from one mistake to the next. And that lessened the fun for me. A lot. I cut her some slack in the beginning of the series, because her life pretty much went down the drain when her mother died and she had to move to her grandpa, who is a near stranger to her and lives in a cabin in the woods in very rural Arkansas. That said, I was annoyed with her behavior in books 1 and 2 as well, because she makes some really stupid decisions, none can understand - one of those gets her bitten by a werewolf and as a result, she has to submit to the members of the Fenner pack and her life and plans for the future are pretty much ruined. But in this installment, Kat's erratic behavior reaches unbelievable heights. She changes her mind so many times that you soon realize that there is no way to rely on anything she says. And neither can the people around her rely on any of her statements. I'm not exaggerating: at the beginning of a page, she decides to run away, in the middle of the same page, she decides to stay and at the bottom of said page, she suggests to another to leave with her. And this is just one example - but it happens constantly. Annoying. Another thing I disliked about Kat is her letting other people treat her badly and not think anything about it. Yes, she is frustrated when she has to do the submissive pack-member-thing, but when her "friend" Cordelia is not behaving like a friend and Kat is happy about it, because she can see "some of the old Cordelia" [= before having been banished from the Fenner pack], I'm just like: Umm, what? And still there is this love/lust-triangle that I do not care for: Justin, the werewolf of her pack, whom obviously her "inner wolf" wants to mate with and Vladimir "Trick" Solokov, whom her human self likes. Well, firstly none of the guys is a real prize. Justin is worse, but Trick doesn't really treat her any better. So, I don't get it. And as I said before: I detest the "my body makes me want to kiss that guy..."-angle. That triangle is resolved at the end, but I have to wonder, if one can really say that these were deliberately made decisions or rather "things just happening that way". Still, the story is interesting and has some twists, I did not see coming. The trilogy is wrapped up fully and leaves no questions open. I did not like some of the too convenient developments that had a "Deus Ex Machina" feeling to it, but still, as a conclusion of the story, it was all right.
