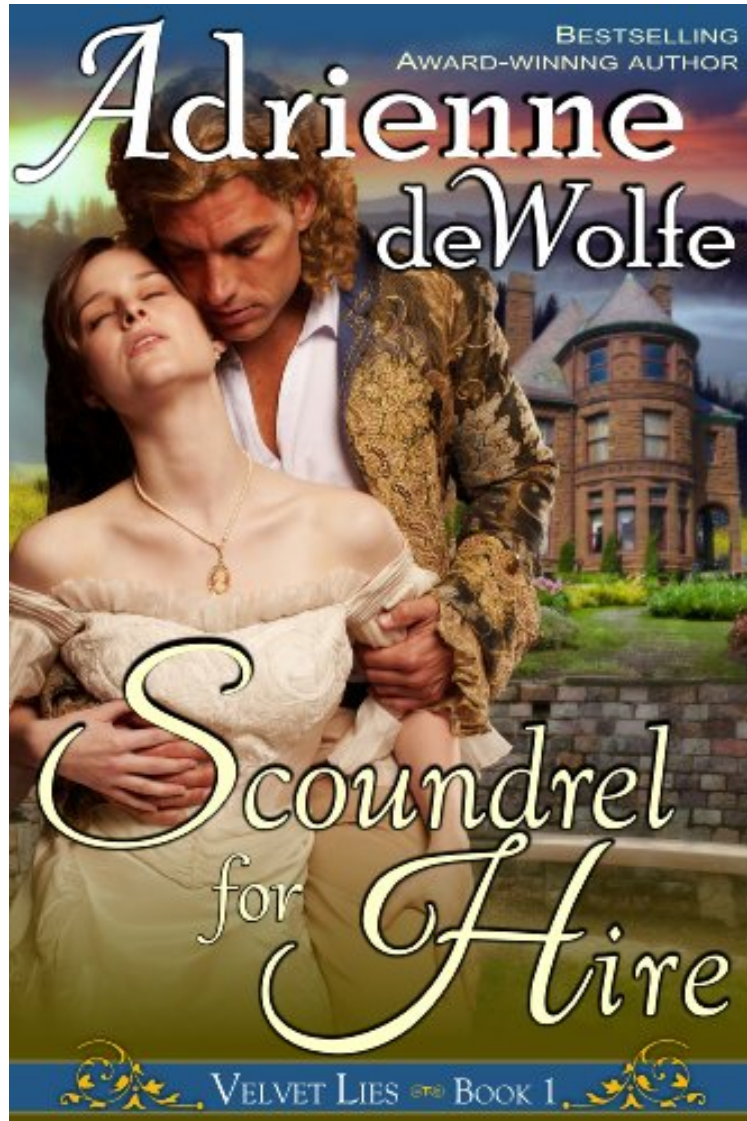

Instead of turning in the glib talking Rafe, Silver hires him to impersonate a British aristocrat who is to seduce Celestia. However, Rafe is attracted to the intelligent and beautiful Silver, whose fortune makes her even prettier to the scoundrel. He decides to seduce her as well as Celestia until love burns inside his heart. **SCOUNDREL FOR HIRE** is a humorous western romance that will enchant sub-genre fans into seeking other works by the talented Adrienne de Wolfe (see **TEXAS OUTLAW** and **TEXAS WILDCAT**). The story line is entertaining due to the wickedly witty exchanges between characters, including a ghost. Silver is a delightful lead female protagonist, but the book belongs to that rascal, Rafe, robber of readers' hearts. This is another winner for Adrienne de Wolfe.
