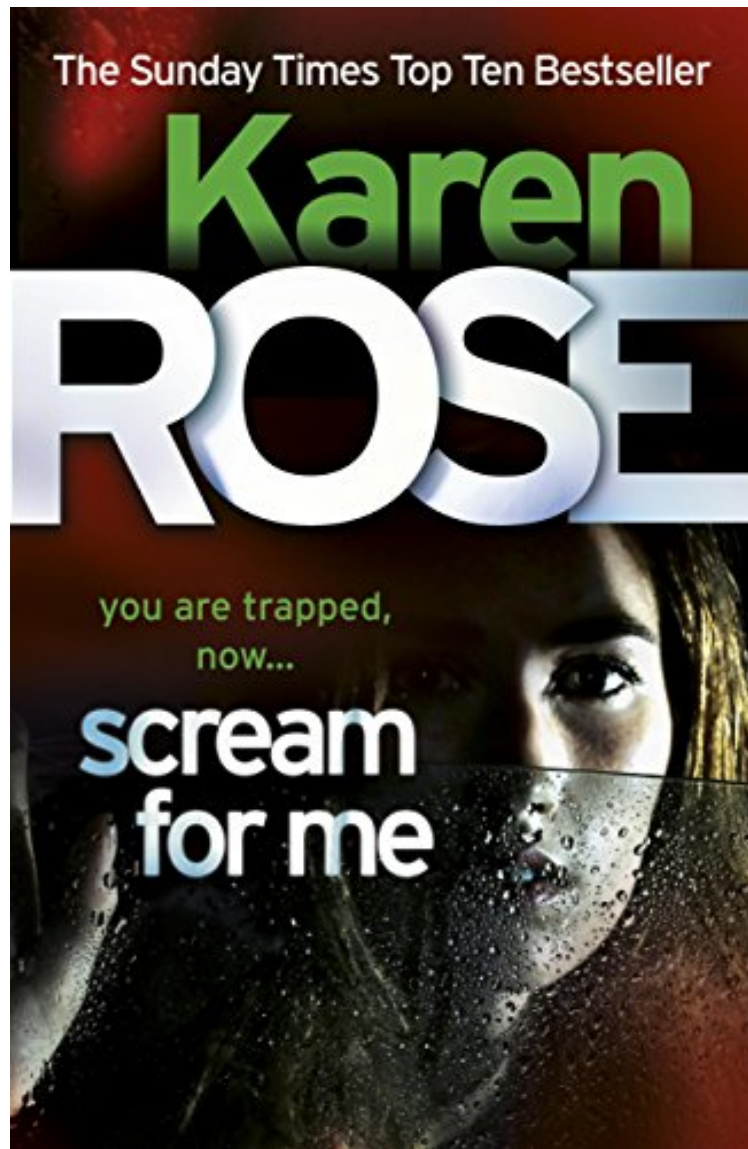

That's "Scream for Me" in a nutshell. IMHO the contents is a bit too big for the nutshell, however. Rose populates her hardcover debut with a plethora of characters and most of them are not developed very well. The characters are involved in too many subplots. The subplots made the story line feel contrived and lengthy at times - about 100 pages less would have been great. Compared to "Die for Me" the romance bit seems to have been thrown in as an afterthought and the ending is far too abrupt and unconvincing. Last but not least: The title is misleading and would have been more fitting for the first book in this mini-series. My criticism may sound harsh, but I was expecting something equally good as Die for Me and was somewhat disappointed. "Scream for Me" is an okay read, although I recommend waiting for the paperback. Am hoping part three (Luke and Susannah?) will be as great as the first one in this series.

Nicht richtig schlecht, aber von Snepius Daniel Vartanian, ein Special Agent, und Bruder des Massenmörders Simon aus dem letzten Buch Die For Me, kommt in seine Heimatstadt und wird mit einem Mord konfrontiert, der einem anderen von 13 Jahren zuvor fast aufs Haar gleicht. Doch es soll nicht bei diesem einen Mord bleiben. Dahinter steckt eine Sache, in die eine Reihe von angesehenen Leuten aus dem Ort verwickelt sind und - Daniels getteter Bruder Simon.
