Well, its a historical romance - one look at the cover shows you that - and theres nothing particularly unusual within its pages to mark it out as special within the genre. Theres an earl, a marquess, a few unmarried women looking for husbands, an opera singer, a country house party, a bossy aunt, all that you might expect to see. Oh, and a ridiculous title that Im sure the author didnt choose. What was different about this book was that the action almost entirely took place inside peoples heads. Not that other things didnt happen - there were some trips out, a game of charades etc - but the meat of the story is not about what people do but about what they think and the masks they put up to hide their true selves. Our hero Alex, Lord Xavier, exists behind a persona hes developed over the years - the rakish aristocrat. Bookworm Louisa Oliver is thought of as a bluestocking but she, too, would like to widen her horizons. The interplay between the two - Louisa as the first person who really sees Alex, and Alex only now beginning to let someone see the real him - is excellently written. I always find it hard to believe in the true reformation of rakes in this kind of story but not at all in this book - I was absolutely convinced. I very much enjoy character-driven plots and both hero and heroine in this story were very appealing, particularly as they made mistakes which we could see. However, I didnt find myself glued to this book at all - although it was good it wasnt particularly gripping. Once again I find it hard to define why - it may be a historical romance with a rake that needs reforming but the story is much more than that.
