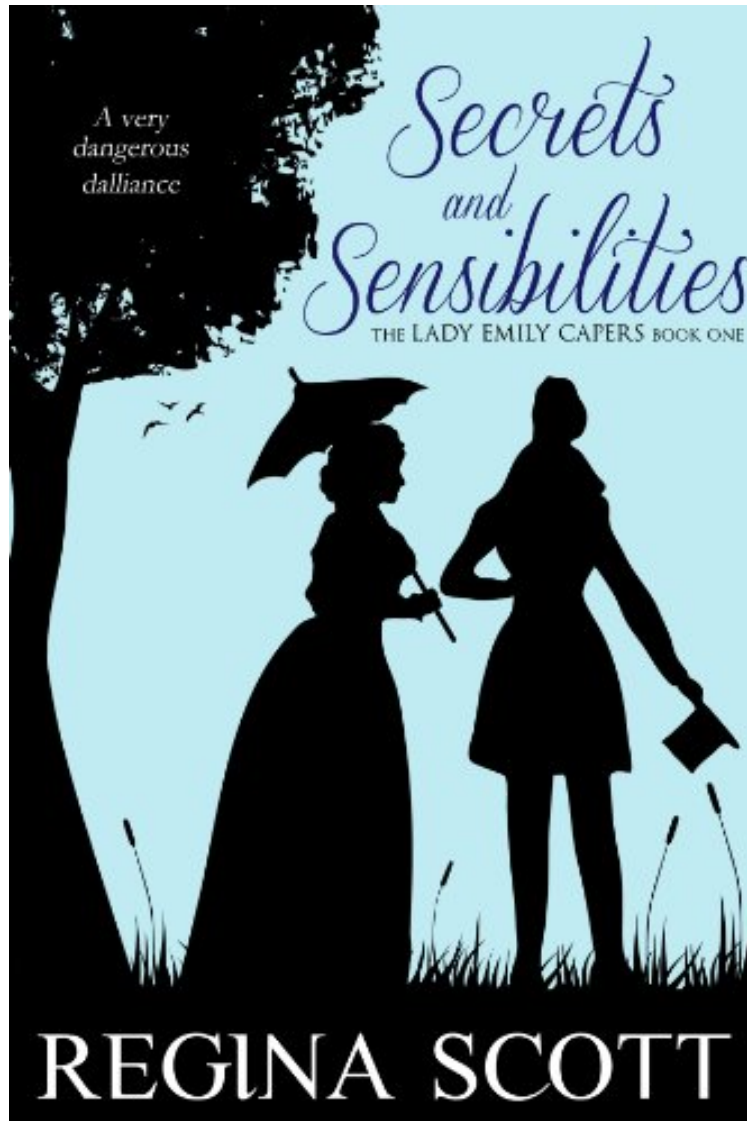

(She has plans to become a portrait painter and has already completed a couple of commissions.) When Lady Brentfield, Priscilla Tate's aunt, invites her niece and three friends for Easter holiday, Hannah is assigned to play chaperone and accompany her students to the country home. Before Hannah even finishes descending from the carriage at the country home, she meets a handsome man with the hands of a crafter. She quickly learns the leather craftsman is actually the new Earl of Brentfield, recently arrived from America. From that first meeting David Tenant makes his interest in Hannah clear to all. So it is not hard to understand why Lady Brentfield shows instant antipathy toward the art instructor. David informs Hannah that he would like her help. The house is honeycombed with secret passageways and within them he and his servant/friend, Mr. Asheram Ash, have located several valuable pieces of art. Ash has been reviewing the papers on Brentfield for David and has identified a number of discrepancies between what was supposed to be inherited and what was actually in evidence. He also uncovered information that indicated that the previous earl and his son might not have died accidentally. Hannah is too intrigued not to assist David, as long as it does not interfere with her duties to her charges.
